02. Expo Timings are 10am to 2 pm for Business Visitors and 2 pm to 8 pm General Visitors on the designated days. The exhibitor undertakes to keep their stands attended and accessible to the public during the said duration.

ADMISSION

03. The products and presentations mentioned in this form (by the exhibitor) are admitted at the exhibition. The exhibitor may display items not mentioned in the form provided the exhibit must be relevant to the exhibitor and to the industry. The organizer reserves the right to exclude exhibition items and exhibitors with a valid show cause note. Subletting is absolutely prohibited. Exhibitors may share the stall with co-exhibitors if permitted by the organizer.

07. Exhibits must not intrude gangway or hazard visitors or other exhibitors. Any exhibit/ process which generate noxious or toxic fumes and/or smoke of any kind should have an effective exhaust system. Fuel must be kept in a controlled store for flammable items. Any running machinery and working exhibits shall be efficiently guarded to the satisfaction of the organizer. The organizer is empowered to order the permanent cessation of a working exhibit or display if two or more adjacent exhibitors should object to the noise or any other disturbance resulting from such a working exhibit or display.
08. Exhibitors with Raw Indoor and Outdoor Space are to submit stall design with the front/side elevations, special features & electrical plan etc to obtain a feasibility check and approval from the organizer. Exhibitors are required to comply with instructions issued by the organizer regarding the schedule for setting up and dismantling the stalls. Failure will attract penal charges charged by the venue authorities which shall be borne by the exhibitor.
09. The standard height of the stall is 2.5 meters and a stall exceeding the said dimension will need organizers approval.
10. The exhibitor is unlimitedly liable for damage caused by them to the people or property at the venue during installation, fair duration and/or dismantling periods.
11. The organizer shall not be responsible for any loss whatsoever incurred by the exhibitor. The exhibitor should obtain insurance coverage for their exhibits against all risks for the period covering preparation, fair duration, dismantling and return transit.
12. Counter Sales are not permitted at the exhibition. However, exhibitors can dispose of their exhibits/equipments on completion of the exhibition. In case of sale of goods/exhibits, central and state taxes applicable will be the direct responsibility of the exhibitor.
13. Overseas exhibitors will be allowed duty free import of exhibits for display, subject to re-export within a period of 6 months from the date of import to India. India is a signatory of ATA Carnet, exhibitors who wish to send their goods for display at this show can use ATA Carnet or Embassy Guarantee or Bank Guarantee. The exhibits can be cleared through the Indian Customs duty, against any of these instruments. The organizer can help the exhibitors in procedures and obtaining these from the relevant offices. Reasonable quantities of printed material for distribution at the exhibition are also allowed duty free. However gift items are subject to duty as applicable on the date of import. Duty free import facility will be allowed only to overseas exhibitors who book space and make payment of participation costs in foreign exchange. Indian counterparts of the overseas exhibitors are not allowed the facility of duty free import. Damage or loss of exhibits will attract customs duties and exhibitors are responsible for the payment of duties. Duties on sales of equipment are normally paid by the buyer.
14. Any kind of advertising is allowed within the exhibitor's own stall for approved products/ services. It is not allowed in common/general areas
15. Excessive sound and light effects not in line with the scope of this exhibition are prohibited.
16. Presentations at the exhibition stand are permitted only within the stall and not in general areas/ hallways or parking and/ or to the annoyance of other exhibitors.
17. Affixing of labels with indications such as sold and its like is not permitted.
18. Opinion polls are permitted only in own stalls.
19. Commercial rights protection for utility models, design patents and trademarks is the responsibility of the exhibitor.
20. For the duration of the exhibition, the exhibitor undertakes to avoid all kinds of actions and measures that may represent a violation of good faith and due care and of the regulations of the law on unfair trade practices.

21.
